

## The ReStore: A unique way of recycling usable construction materials, cabinets, appliances and more!

Summit & Wasatch counties are among the fastest-growing counties in the nation. That's a good thing. But construction activities generate over 40% of the solid waste in our landfills.

When contractors remodel, or changes and errors occur during construction, good usable materials end up in the landfill. Odd lots of lumber that remain after the job is over end up there too.

**Why throw good stuff away when other people can use it?!**

Recycle Utah's ReStore is the best answer to good construction waste!

### Goals of the ReStore

- Develop partnerships with local contractors to obtain "good" wood at new construction sites.
- Capture other building materials such as doors, windows, sinks, toilets, hardware and fixtures from remodel projects.
- Reuse working appliances such as washers, dryers, stoves, and refrigerators.
- Provide a community thrift store for the sale of wood and other desirable materials.
- Promote efficient use of wood and household resources.
- Extend the life of Summit County's landfills.

## About Recycle Utah

In 1991, a group of concerned citizens established the Park City Conservation Association to collect recycling, promote water conservation, and envision a zero waste plan for Summit County, Utah. The nonprofit prevents 200 tons of recyclables from being landfilled every month. The Park City center accepts 40 different items from households and businesses and maintains satellite collection locations in Kimball Junction, Coalville, Kamas and Heber. Environmental teachers visit 4,000 school children in classrooms every year. The nonprofit serves about 80,000 people in Summit and Wasatch Counties.

### Mission

Look for the recycling symbol on or near the bottom of plastic containers:  
plastic # 1 - pop bottles, water bottles, etc  
plastic # 2 - milk jugs, etc.



If you see no symbol, plastic can be recycled as "mixed plastic" #3-7.



The recycling symbol with a percentage inside indicates the percentage of recycled content in a product such as paper or cardboard.

## Materials Accepted

### Recycle Utah Center, Woodbine Way:

Aluminum cans

Corrugated cardboard, paperboard, waxed cartons with plastic removed



EPS white block packing foam

Glass: clear, green, brown, blue

Mixed metal, steel/tin cans

Mixed paper — newspaper, magazines, catalogues, phone books, books, paper bags and “any paper that comes in the mail.”

White & pastel office paper

## Plastics Tent

Plastic bags — grocery bags, clean inner bags from cereal and cracker boxes, other plastic bags

**#1 PETE plastics** (mostly transparent soda, juice & water bottles). Please rinse, crush, and remove caps which are recycled separately.

**#2 HDPE opaque plastics** (milk jugs, water jugs) please, no solid colored plastics — rinse, crush and remove caps.

**#2—#7 Colored & Mixed Plastics** — rinse, crush, and remove caps — NO food residue, NO metal, NO Styrofoam, NO rubber.

Large plastic items such as lawn chairs, buckets, bins, etc. are accepted in the bailing bay

## EPS Packing Foam Collection

**EPS foam blocks-** no food containers or drinking cups. Foam will be densified to reduce volume. Packing peanuts are accepted inside the office.

## E-Waste Collection Daily

TVs, microwaves, computers, keyboards, CPUs, printers, laptops, any electronics.



## Moving Boxes & Packing Materials Reuse Program

Donate moving boxes, bubble wrap, packing peanuts, and packing paper for others to reuse.

## Batteries, Cell Phones, CDs, Printer Cartridges, Jewel Cases

Recycle alkaline batteries, rechargeable batteries (ni-cd, Ni-Mh, Li-ion, or Pb), empty ink & toner cartridges, cellular telephones, pagers, PDAs, ipods, CDs, jewel cases.

## Mercury Containing Items

CFLs, light tubes, mercury thermometers & thermostats.

## Yard Waste Reduction & Composting

Use only lawn mowers with mulching blades. Learn how to start composting. Earth Machine composters & compost carriers for sale.

## Other Locations

- Kimball Junction (WalMart parking lot) mixed paper & aluminum cans only
- Kamas (behind Summit County Library) mixed paper & aluminum cans only
- Coalville (Fire Station Parking Lot) mixed paper, aluminum cans, mixed glass only
- Heber City (Smith's Food Parking Lot) mixed paper only
